## 2022 Miss. Power Pageant Handbook

### ELIGIBILITY & ACCEPTANCE

#### **Eligibility:**

- Have and maintain a 2.7 Grade Point Average. Copy of official Report card must be provided/attached to application submission.
- Must be in grades 9, 10, 11 or 12<sup>th</sup>
- Registration Fee \$25 (payable to Empowered Incorporated)
- Sell 5 Program Book Ads
- Sell 10 tickets

#### **STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT ENTRY FEE PAYMENTS**

An entry fee is required to enter the Ms. Power Pageant as a Contestant. Payment may be made by Zelle, Venmo, Cash App or Check.

The Miss. Power pageant is self-supporting and uses entry fees to cover some of the production expenses. Production expenses include but are not limited to advertising, hotel rentals, theater rentals, performers' fees, judges, staging, supplies, awards, etc. A significant percentage of the entry fee is directed back to each Contestant in the form of crown, sash, entertainment, fellowships, gifts, and awards.

#### **Entry Fee Covers:**

- \* Grade Verification  
& GPA verification
- \* Community Service/Extracurricular Verification
- \* Awards

#### **Entry Fee does NOT Cover**

- \* Travel fees incurred
- \* Rehearsals
- \* Hair & Make up

The registration fee paid to Empowered Incorporated Miss Power pageant is NOT REFUNDABLE and NOT TRANSFERABLE in full or in part under any circumstances. This includes, but is not limited to entry fees, advertising fees, seat sales, and any other fees paid to Empowered Incorporated Miss. Power pageant by anyone including, but not limited to, Contestants, sponsors, and advertisers.

## **DEADLINES**

The entry deadlines to compete in the Miss. Power pageant is **May 31, 2022** at 11:59p.m., Pacific Standard Time. **All Contestant paperwork and headshot photo for the Official Program Book must be received by July 31, 2022.**

## **COMPETITION JUDGING**

**Interview Competition** - 50%: This will be a panel style interview where the judges get to learn about your successes, goals, and ambitions. Present yourself in a sophisticated, self-confident and professional manner.

**Speech/Talent** - 40%: This portion of the competition will be based upon the theme, “**The Lion King Dan 6**” (The story of Daniel in the Lion’s Den) and will need to last no longer than 5 minutes. At 5:01 minutes, 1 point will be deducted per minute over the 5-minute mark.

**Evening Gown Competition** – 10%: Each contestant will wear a gown chosen for herself. Please ensure that your gown is age appropriate!

## **JUDGING**

- A minimum of 3 judges will evaluate Contestants in the areas of competition
- Empowered Incorporated has sole discretion and complete authority to select judges.
- Judges are provided with training and instruction regarding scoring procedures prior to the competition.
- The decision of the judges is final and not contestable for any reason.
- Scores will be made available to Miss. Power and her court by one day after the pageant. All other scores will be mailed out.

## **SCORING:**

Scoring is conducted on a 5-point scale:

- 5 = Excellent
- 4 = Above Average
- 3 = Average
- 2 = Fair
- 1 = Poor

**THE CONTESTANT WITH THE HIGHEST** cumulative score after penalties, if any, have been deducted from judges’ scores, will be announced as pageant winners. Violation of any pageant rule may result in contestant disqualification or ineligibility to participate.

### **BREAKING TIES**

The following procedure is used to **break ties**. Each Contestant will be asked an on-stage question during the evening gown competition. The questions will be drawn at random. The Contestant will not get an opportunity to view the questions prior to the pageant. The Contestant with the highest points received on the question will be crowned the winner.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

Contestants will conduct herself in a courteous, professional manner at all times during the preparation of the Miss Power Pageant and while representing the Miss. Power Pageant title. Contestant will not slander or libel other contestants, judges, staff, or anyone else involved with or connected to Empowered Incorporated and the Miss. Power Pageant. Defamatory verbal and/or written remarks against Empowered Inc, United Sisters Symposium and the Miss. Power Pageant will result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of any and all prizes and awards won, and legal charges. Any Contestant found publicly posting slanderous remarks on public forums will be immediately disqualified. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Disruptive behavior before, during, or after the pageant may result in disqualification, removal from the premises, and legal charges. All issues related to the Code of Conduct and consequences for violation thereof shall be determined solely and exclusively by Empowered Incorporated and the Miss. Power Pageant. Contestant agrees to accept such determinations made by Empowered Incorporated, and the Miss. Power Pageant.

### **PARTICIPATION IN PAGEANT EVENTS**

Contestants are expected to be on time and present for all scheduled rehearsals and events leading up to and during the pageant finals. Contestants will lose 1 point for each unexcused missed event. In the event of illness, a Contestant may be excused from attending an event. The Miss. Power Pageant CEO, Chairperson and/or Co-Chairpersons are the only individuals with the authority to release a Contestant from a scheduled event.

### **WINNER'S CONTRACT**

If selected as the Miss. Power Pageant Winner, the Contestant agrees to sign a contract stating agreement to arrange and make a minimum of 4 appearances throughout her reign. Appearances may include but are not limited to volunteer activities; parades; radio, television, newspaper interviews; and public appearances at events. If Contestant is unwilling to sign the contract and/or unable or unwilling to fulfill the obligations, the title won and all prizes will be awarded to the first runner up. The reign of the Miss. Power Pageant winner will commence immediately after crowning and will end immediately following the crowning of their successor. The winner is expected to give her time and energy to the respective title held during their year's reign. All Miss. Power Pageant winners agree to attend the next year's pageant to crown their successor.
